Sub: Extension of National Control Room for six months for effective implementation of the ban on identified single-use plastic items.

A National Control Room (NCR) was established in CPCB to oversee the countrywide enforcement campaign during December 2025 to February 2026 for effective implementation of the ban on identified single-use plastic (SUP) items, in accordance with the decisions taken in the Ninth Meeting of the National Task Force held on 20.11.2025. Further, as per MoEF&CC O.M. dated 02.12.2025, the enforcement campaign will be conducted for one month in every quarter to ensure coordinated implementation of the ban across the country.

In view of the above and in continuation of office Order dated 11.12.2025, it is hereby informed that the National Control Room (NCR) has been extended for a further period of six (6) months, i.e., from 01.03.2026 to 31.08.2026, to oversee and monitor the countrywide enforcement of the ban on identified SUP items.

The NCR shall continue to provide guidance and clarification to stakeholders, monitor enforcement actions by SPCBs/PCCs and other authorities, coordinate awareness activities, and compile weekly reports for submission to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.

National Control Room established in CPCB for effective implementation of ban on identified single-use plastic (SUP) items

A National Control Room (NCR) to oversee the countrywide enforcement campaign during December 2025-February, 2026 for effective implementation of ban on identified single-use plastic (SUP) items has been established in CPCB in accordance with the decisions taken in the ninth meeting of the National Task Force, held on 20th November 2025 under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, MoEF&CC, Government of India.

The NCR shall remain operational from **December 2025 to February 28, 2026** and will facilitate activities related to the effective implementation and monitoring of the ban on identified SUP items. The NCR shall undertake, inter alia, the following functions:

(a) Provide assistance, guidance, clarification and information to various stakeholders regarding the ban on SUP items, including but not limited to:

- Specific items covered under / excluded from the SUP Ban.
- Availability and types of alternatives to banned SUP items in respective States/UTs.
- Guidance on filing complaints through the SUP Public Grievance App.
- Assistance for use and operation of the SUP Compliance Monitoring Portal and Field Inspection App.
- Information related to compostable plastic manufacturers: certification procedure, testing facilities and list of certified compostable plastics manufacturers across the country.
- Addressing general queries received from citizens, traders, manufacturers and enforcement agencies.

(b) The NCR shall monitor enforcement of SUP ban through concerned State Authorities including tracking inspection status, compliance and enforcement actions.

(c) Coordination of activities related to Awareness campaign on SUP.

The Control Room shall be operational during **December 2025 to February 28, 2026** between 9:30 AM to 6:00 PM. The National Control Room team can be contacted at 011-43102460/469, and queries related to SUP may be addressed to **sup.cpcb@gov.in**

CPCB has issued Directions to SPCBs/PCCs to set up the State Level Control Room for enforcement of the campaign at the State level on similar lines. The State Boards are required to provide weekly reports related to the implementation of the ban on SUP to CPCB. CPCB shall prepare the weekly national-level compliance report on the SUP ban based on the activities undertaken by CPCB/SPCBs/PCCs.

The State Boards have further been directed to undertake comprehensive awareness activities, including social media campaigns, and interactive meetings with industries, colleges, schools, and other institutions on SUP. They have also been directed to intensify inspections of industrial and commercial establishments for effective implementation of the ban.

All States/UTs have been directed to ensure that complete information is provided on the CPCB Compliance Monitoring Portal and the SUP Public Grievance App to facilitate enforcement and effective monitoring of the implementation of the SUP ban.
